



Dr. Han-Shih Toh Chief Analyst Headland Intelligence

Toh Han Shih is a Singaporean man who has been living in Hong Kong since 2003.

He is currently chief analyst of Headland Intelligence, a Hong Kong risk consulting firm. He is also a freelance journalist.

In his previous career, he has been a journalist reporting on business and economics related to greater China for more than 15 years.

From October 2018 to June 2019, he was senior reporter of FinanceAsia, a Hong Kong-based financial magazine, where he reported on the debt markets of China including Hong Kong as well as other countries.

From November 2015 to March 2018, he was senior correspondent of MLEX, a news agency focusing on regulatory risk, where he reported on financial regulations, cryptocurrency, money laundering, fraud and corruption related to greater China.

Prior to that, he was a reporter in South China Morning Post, Hong Kong's leading English-language newspaper, for a total of 10 years in two stints.

He has written a book that was published, named "Is China an empire?", which discusses Chinese overseas investments and overseas infrastructure projects, as well as their impact on the world.

He has a Master's of Economics from Hong Kong University, an M.A. in Southeast Asian studies from the London School of Oriental and African Studies, a Doctor of Philosophy in theoretical physics from Oxford University and a B.S. in physics from the California Institute of Technology.
