In UOBAM, he managed the United Asian Bond Fund, which won 8 Lipper Fund Awards between 2010–2014 in the Asia Pacific bonds category, Morningstar Singapore's Best Asia Bond Fund award in 2013 and Asia Asset Management's best Asian Bonds in 2014.

During his stint in UOBAM, he also managed United Asian High Yield Bond Fund and United Renminbi Bond Fund, both of which have one of the best performance track records among its peers.

Tse Chern was an economist with Credit Suisse between 1998-2006, covering Southeast Asia and India. He was voted 2nd best economist covering Malaysia in 2003 by Asiamoney Education
